Household goods/Personal effects - Foreigners	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Sea shipments<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Copy of front page of client's passport and the page showing ITAS validity stamp (passport# as per registered on IMTA) - coloured copy</li><li>Indonesia work permit/IMTA still valid - coloured copy</li><li>Indonesia resident permit/ITAS still valid - coloured copy</li><li>EPO stamp/Exit Permit Only (as soon as available) - coloured copy or Original MERP</li><li>Visa for destination country/Employment pass /residence permit - coloured copy</li><li>Customs form for destination country (if applicable) - copy</li><li>Reference letter or "Surat Keterangan" from local company in Indonesia - original</li><li>Statement letter for shipper signature/return - original</li><li>Authorization letter for shipper signature/return - original</li><li>Copy of flight ticket and departure stamp when leaving Indonesia</li></ul></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Must declare at least 5 items on packing list, BL.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Do not include the following items in an Air shipment:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Foodstuff, medicines, liquids and gels of any kind (toiletries, deodorant, perfume, cosmetics, hand cream, paint, cleaning powders, solvent, etc.), any device that contains lithium batteries i.e. non-removable or removable batteries, printer ink cartridges, flammable and combustible liquids, corrosives, lighters, barbeque grill propane gas tanks, oxygen tanks, aerosols, glue products, jewellerys, negotiable stock certificates or currency, animal furs and skins, and etc.</li></ul></li></ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Air shipments <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Copy of front page of client's passport and the page showing ITAS validity stamp (passport# as per registered on IMTA) - coloured copy.</li> <li>▪ Indonesia work permit/IMTA - still valid - coloured copy.</li> <li>▪ Indonesia resident permit/ITAS - still valid - coloured copy.</li> <li>▪ Flight ticket/E-ticket for destination country MUST be SAME with shipment destination - coloured copy.</li> <li>▪ Departure stamp from Immigration when leaving Indonesia.</li> <li>▪ Visa for destination country/ Employment pass/residence permit - coloured copy.</li> <li>▪ Check list for hidden dangerous goods for shipper completion /return - copy.</li> <li>▪ Reference letter or "Surat Keterangan" from local company in Indonesia- coloured copy.</li> <li>▪ Statement letter for shipper signature/return - original.</li> <li>▪ Authorization letter for shipper signature/return - original.</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ Air &amp; sea shipment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Passport # registered in IMTA, if shipper has a new passport, please include the same (coloured copy of all used pages).</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Departure stamp from Immigration when leaving Indonesia.</li> <li>▪ Visa for destination country/ Employment pass/residence permit - coloured copy.</li> <li>▪ Check list for hidden dangerous goods for shipper completion/return - copy.</li> <li>▪ Statement Letter from Local Employer stating that shipper will move - original</li> <li>▪ Statement Letter from client stating that he/ she will not bring out any prohibited items, with duty stamp – original</li> <li>▪ Authorization letter for shipper signature/return - original.</li> </ul>		
<b>Household goods - Diplomats or Semi Diplomats</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Sea and Air shipments - For diplomatic status: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Front page passport - scan colour endorsed by embassy.</li> <li>▪ Diplomatic ID card - scan colour endorsed by embassy.</li> <li>▪ Stay permit/ITAS - scan colour endorsed by embassy.</li> <li>▪ EPO stamp/Exit Permit Only (as soon as available) - scan colour endorsed by embassy.</li> <li>▪ Recommendation Letter from Ministry of Foreign Department and the Diplomatic Note.</li> <li>▪ Statement letter from shipper stating that he/ she is not bringing out any prohibited items - original.</li> <li>▪ Power of Attorney letter/Surat kuasa signed by the client for the agent to handle this shipment - original.</li> <li>▪ Reference letter from embassy which stating that client will move - original.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Commence the clearance upon shipment arrival and receiving these docs.</li> <li>▪ If client cannot provide all required paper works, the shipment cannot be custom clearance and released from the port on duty free basis.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Copy of Flight Ticket from Indonesia to destination country and Departure Stamp from Immigration at airport</li> <li>▪ Visa or residence permit or working permit at destination country (if any) – colour copy endorsed by the embassy.</li> <li>▪ Sea and Air shipments - For semi-diplomatic status (U.N., UNICEF, WHO...): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Front page passport - scan colour endorsed by the organization (local office).</li> <li>▪ ID card - scan colour endorsed by the organization (local office).</li> <li>▪ Stay permit / ITAS - scan colour endorsed by the organization (local office).</li> <li>▪ EPO stamp/Exit Permit Only (as soon as available) - scan colour endorsed by the organization (local office).</li> <li>▪ Recommendation Letter from Ministry of Foreign Department and the Semi - Diplomatic Note.</li> <li>▪ Statement letter from shipper stating that he/ she is not bringing out any prohibited items - original.</li> <li>▪ Power of Attorney letter/Surat kuasa signed by the client for the agent to handle this shipment - original.</li> <li>▪ Reference letter shipper from the organization stating that client will move - original.</li> <li>▪ Copy of Flight Ticket from Indonesia to destination country and Departure Stamp from Immigration at airport.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Motor vehicles and/or motorbikes		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Must have De-registration documents from the Police Authority</li> <li>▪ Must have Reference Letter from Police Authority that the vehicle or motorbike will be exported to destination country</li> </ul>	
Foodstuffs		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Non-perishable food items may be exported in small amounts.</li> </ul>	
Alcohol		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Export of alcohol is allowed for FULL DIPLOMATS ONLY but limited to annual quota agreed by the local Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the respective embassies in the country. Alcohol is prohibited for non-full diplomats.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Including wine, spirits, and beer.</li> </ul>
Prohibited Items		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Firearms.</li> <li>▪ Ammunition (including air guns).</li> <li>▪ Pornography.</li> <li>▪ Politically sensitive material.</li> <li>▪ Narcotics.</li> <li>▪ Illicit drugs.</li> </ul>	
CD's; DVD's; VCD's; Video/Audio tapes, books	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Detailed listing at packing list as long not new and adult Video.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Can be exported in 'reasonable' quantities provided they are not pornographic or politically sensitive or against Moslem.</li> </ul>	
Pets (Dogs & Cats)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Export permit.</li> <li>▪ Current Original Health certificate.</li> <li>▪ Current rabies vaccination certificate (must score not less than 0.5) issued more than 30 days before arrival in Indonesia but not older than 1 year.</li> <li>▪ Current vaccination book.</li> <li>▪ Original quarantine documents from the</li> </ul>
