Personal effects Vehicles	<ul> <li>Non-diplomats and returning citizens:</li> <li>Copy of passport</li> <li>Detailed inventory in English, dated, valued, and signed by the shipper</li> <li>Non-resale certificate</li> <li>Washington Convention</li> <li>Personal Tax Identification Number (TIN). Not the company TIN number</li> <li>Form confirming client's contact details.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>All non-diplomats, including returning citizens, will have to pay customs taxes and duties on their imported personal effects.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>No tax on air shipments if all are used personal effects. Brand new Items may be subjected for duty.</li> <li>The TIN number shows that the employer or the shipper is registered with the National Revenue Authority (NRA). Diplomats	<ul> <li>Copy of passport</li> <li>Detailed inventory in English, dated, valued, and signed by the shipper</li> <li>Non-resale certificate</li> <li>Washington Convention.</li> </ul>		<ul> <li>No tax on air shipments</li> <li>Duty Exemption has to be obtained from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Finance and NRA by the shipper's diplomatic mission in collaboration with your local mover.</li> <li>Diplomatic sea shipments attract an additional charge of 250 USD per shipment to process the diplomatic duty-free documentation.</li> <li>The exemption process for diplomats can take between 30 to 60 days. Additional port storage and demurrage charges can be expected.</li> <li>Added to the Document Exemption process, there is the ASYCUDA Online process that starts only after the container is in the port.</li> </ul>

Motor vehicles	<ul> <li>Original vehicle registration documents</li> <li>Copy of passport</li> <li>Original invoice, or registration documents if vehicle is second hand</li> <li>TIN number</li> <li>Right-Handed Vehicles are prohibited.</li> <li>Vehicle made from 2005 to present are considered Brand New and subject to valuation.</li> </ul>		
Prohibited items		<ul> <li>Illegal drugs</li> <li>Special authorization required for:         <ul> <li>Arms and ammunitions: Ministry of Interior, Intelligence Division</li> <li>Plants: Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry</li> <li>Pharmaceuticals: Ministry of Health.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
Customs clearance duration			<ul> <li>Non-diplomat solo container: 10 working days</li> <li>Diplomatic solo container: 7 to 10 working days when all duty-free process has been completed</li> <li>Groupage (consolidated shipments): delay duration varies – contact your local agent Air: 1 to 3 working days (both for diplomats and non-diplomats).</li> </ul>
